### **Requirements for the recognition of roadworthiness certificates on Danish vehicles in categories O3 and O4**

The Danish Road Traffic Authority hereby confirms that we of the 5<sup>th</sup> of January has implemented national legislation, which allows for the recognition of periodic technical inspection (PTI) on vehicles in category O3 and O4, and thereby to have their annual PTI performed in another Member State.

The model that we have chosen to implement allows for the recognition of roadworthiness certificates, issued by another Member State, if the following requirements are met:

- 1: The owner of the vehicle is responsible for finding an inspection company that fits the requirements.
- 2: The roadworthiness certificate must meet the requirements in Annex II in Directive 2014/45/EU. If it's not possible to fill out the Danish registration plate number, in the corresponding harmonised Union code (2), then it is accepted if only the VIN-number in (1) is filled out.
- 3: The inspection is reported to the national competent authority and is covered by its supervision.
- 4: The owner of the vehicle is responsible for contacting a Danish inspection company, who can report the roadworthiness certificate to the Danish Road Traffic Authority. The last date, for which the vehicle is to be approved in Denmark, must not be passed when the roadworthiness certificate is reported.
